The meeting place for those going is at the Village Inn in Monument. It's right off of I-25.

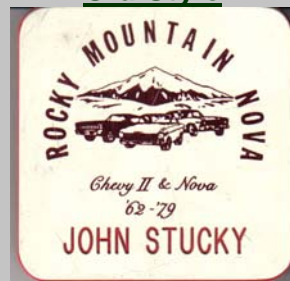
The meeting time is 6:00a.m. The group will leave around 7:15 for Woodland Park.

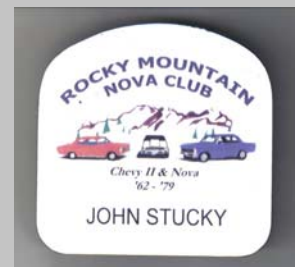
Name Badges

The picnic was at Dave and Sharon Bills house again this year. Each year the Bills open there home to all of us for the club's

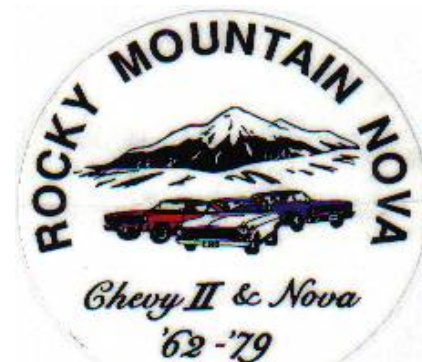
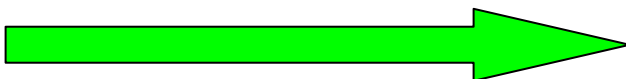

As we ate, we all sat around and chatted with each other and got caught up on new things, shows and family. And what to do with our Nova's, and how to do it.

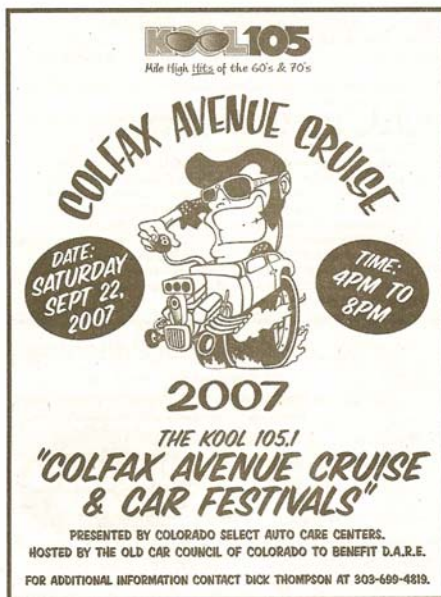
I hope that Dave & Sharon continue to do this during their retirement and I want to give them a very special thank you for having us into their beautiful home.

2007 Colfax Ave. Cruise & Car Festivals

The **Colfax Avenue Cruise & Car Festivals** are planned for **September 22, 2007**. This is an event that Old Car Council of Colorado has had in the planning stage for two years. Sponsorship is in place and here is what is planned.



The three sites are **Festival Plaza (Across from Invesco Field) at 3200 W Colfax, East High School at 2300 W Colfax and the Super Kmart at 15200 E Colfax**. Each site will have a car display with OCCC member cars, music, food vendors, car club displays, and other car-related displays by vendors. The sites will operate from 4 pm to 8 pm. The car club members working at the sites will help with site set-up, operation, and site clean up. The Colorado Pontiac-Oakland Club will be teamed with the Mile Hi Cobra Club, Packard Club and the VMCCA to operate the site at East High School. The Sabers Club and the AMC Club will handle the Aurora site and the Denver Roadsters and the ColoRODans will host the Festival Plaza site.

The promotion of the Colfax Avenue Cruise will be by radio station KOOL105. The radio station will also help with music at each of the sites. The charity to benefit from the event is D.A.R.E.. D.A.R.E officers will be present at each site and have a display vehicle and giveaways for kids. The main sponsors of the event are the network of Colorado Select Auto Care Centers & NAPA Auto Parts. The money

from the sponsors will be used to finance operation of the sites (permits, security, rental of equipment), fund a donation to D.A.R.E., and the fund the operation of OCCC. The car clubs operating the sites will profit from the sale of tee shirts and fees from the vendors at the sites.

The **Colfax Avenue Cruise** is going to be great and a chance to get in on the ground floor of this annual event. This event needs your support. We need to have a variety of cars at each site on Saturday, September 22

I talked with Dick Thompson and he described the Colfax Cruise to me as three separate car shows and if you want you can cruise from one to another. There will be no organized cruise and Colfax will not be shut down and will be open to Reg. traffic. Tom Koehler
