RMNC Meeting Minutes for 1/23/08

Rocky Mountain Nova Club Meeting Minutes - January 23rd, 2008

Meeting to order 7:35pm - 23 Members in attendance.

Dan introduced New Members James Taylor and fiancé Esther, and introduced the Officers for them.

Jan Ellinger gave the Treasurers report. Member's dues are due by the end of January, or you will lose your membership.

Prior to the decision for Insurance for the Club, Rick Ellinger gave a perspective on NNN insurance and why the club went that way in the past, and Dan gave a perspective on the ACE insurance and what they offer us as a club, to refresh the members present. Stuck and Scott Yockstick gave their opinions mostly for the new members. A vote was taken and the Majority voted for the ACE (Association of Chevy Enthusiasts) Insurance. The requirement to belong to NNN will be stricken from the By-laws and Jan Ellinger will change the State License to eliminate mention of NNN. Dan will call NNN and let them know. We will no longer be a chapter of NNN. Any member who wishes to remain a member of NNN, or wants to join NNN is free to do so.

Tom Koehler talked about the upcoming Car Show. There are applications and car show sponsor sheets available from Tom. The Car Show workers dinner is set for **Feb 10th at 2:30pm** to eliminate conflict with the Super Bowl on Feb 3rd. Also there will be a CAR SHOW MEETING on Feb 17th at 1:30pm at Perkins, Two blocks west of I-25 and 120th. Tom has not checked into T-shirts yet, but for the Dash Plaques A-1 Trophy will do them for a \$15 setup and \$.99 a piece this year. Last year Jerry Potts charged a \$50 setup. The type of judging (peoples choice or judged) will be discussed at the Car Show Meeting. It was suggested that we do an appreciation Plaque for Go Chevrolet for letting us have a meeting place every month. Tom will check on Plaques and T-Shirts. Tom had made up several posters in different color schemes. He will redo the colors to stand out more and we will select one at the Car Show Meeting. Dan will get the Large Posters printed up.

Stucky updated the members on changes voted on at the By-laws meeting on Jan 12th. There was some fine tuning done at this meeting. The updated By-laws will be available at the Feb. Club Meeting.

OFFICER ELECTIONS - At the By-Laws meeting it was voted on that the Officer's terms would be for Two (2) years. A motion to keep the current officers was brought up, and Scott seconded it.
