Dan talked about the Car Show meeting on Sat Feb 16th and some of the decisions. The Award Plaques from Jerry Potts or A-1 Trophy has not been decided yet, but will be at the Car Show meeting on Mar 9th. Dan "highly" suggested we go with Jerry Potts again. One of the decisions was for (2) Plaques made, one to be presented by GO Chevrolet for Best Non-Member Nova Award, the other an Appreciation Plaque to Go Chevrolet for the use of their meeting room every month.

The Price for the Scoop Ad has gone up from \$110 to \$120. Concerns were brought up if we could go with a smaller ad. Bob Baron has talked to Tracy from the Scoop and she said the first two years an add gets peoples attention, but not so much after that. Tim Redmond suggested that a month after the Car Show, that we have a meeting while it's still fresh in our minds and make decisions about the Car Show stuff instead of waiting until Jan or Feb.

Because of the full schedule in March and April from Car Show preparation, it was decided to postpone Breakfast get-togethers until after the Car Show in May.
