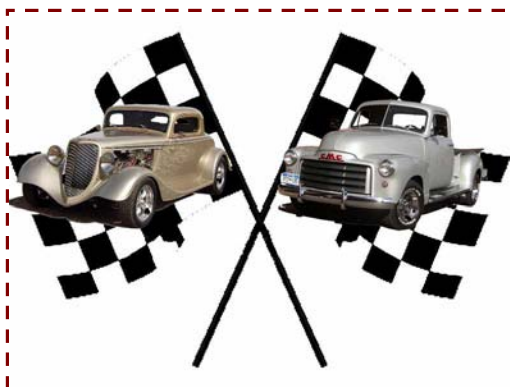
Car Quest will be on site passing out Discount Coupons, good at all Car Quest Stores. They will also be passing out some **FREE** things to everyone!
