This was the first show for U.P.S. They didn't pick a very good day a lot of other shows going on, but still pulled in 51 cars. Next year will be better.

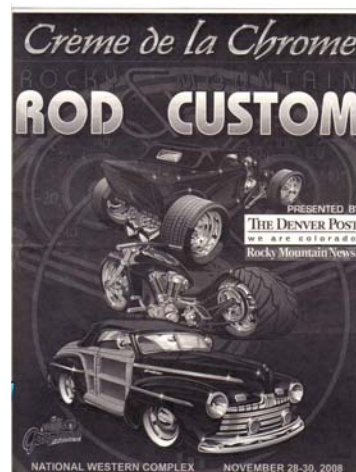
Rod and Custom Show
