December 5th Event provides Sneak Peek into Summer "Toys for Tots" Events

In 2003, an ongoing community service project entitled "Christmas Caravan for Kids" was begun. Each year, in conjunction with area vendors and 4-Wheelers throughout Colorado's Front Range, we sponsor a toy drive and "meet and greet" to benefit the Marine's Toys for Tots Campaign. 4-Wheelers from around the Front Range meet in pre-determined locations and "caravan" to the event site where the USMC's MACS 23rd Air Unit from Buckley Air Force Base is waiting to receive the toys donated by participants. For each of our first two events, we were the second largest single day toy donation the Marines received (second only to the Denver Bronco Toy Drive). In 2005, we became the largest single day donation ever received by Denver's Toys for Tots campaign. Following the toy drive, participants are treated to a "meet and greet" with area vendors which includes a FREE lunch and FREE raffle drawing. Last year our event attracted over 350 vehicles and over 500 participants - and we expect to grow again this year.

2009 Christmas Caravan will be on December 5th, 10 am until 3pm at the Jefferson County Event Center on the fairgrounds at 6th and Indiana. We're inviting Nova Club members to join us for this year's Toys for Tots event. Two reasons - first is more toys for the cause and second to check out the format for a possible "Rod and Custom" event next summer. The idea is for a "Toys for Tots" toy (and \$\$ donations) drive sponsored by the Nova Club in conjunction with Cruzin' Havana, June 19, 2010. We've started conversations with Cruzin' Havana organizers for something like Rocky Mountain Nova Club presents "Cruizin' for Kids".

Preliminary ideas have included the possibility of setting up at one of the 5 check points/staging areas of Cruzin' Havana along with the Marines and do a summer toy and \$\$ donation drive. Perhaps an additional card toward the best poker hand could be given out to everyone who donates a toy.

So, come by on **Dec. 5th**, see what the 4 wheelers are doing and gather ideas for the Nova Club and the Cruzin Havana event. Questions??
