Car Show Committee Meeting Feb 22, 2009

RMNC Car Show Committee Meeting Minutes Feb 22 - 09

13 Members were in attendance
Meeting started at 2:30pm

Tom Koehler started the meeting by passing out Agenda's

1. Top of the list was the Show LOCATION !

Four proposed sites- Heritage Square, Arapahoe Park(44th and Indiana, Golden) Rosie's Diner (Illiff and I-225) Finishline (Bar and Grill) Bowles and E-470.

2. Direct Impressions Artwork
3. Sponsors and door prizes
4. Plaques
5. T- Shirts

Even though Jim Hyatt from Heritage Square has promised several times to get Tom a price list that he told Tom about he never did, but he said that it would be \$500 minimum, no negotiating, just to bring the cars into Heritage Square and could go to \$750 - \$1000 !!! . If this isn't indirectly saying they don't want us I don't know what is.

Kathy talked about Rosie's Diner. There are new owners and they are not sure because they are new to the car show scene. Kathy explained that all we needed was their parking lot and that we would supply everything else (plaques, door prizes music etc) which eased their minds. But they didn't want us interfering with the breakfast crowd, so we would have to wait and start at Noon (12:00pm). Kathy did say that she has seen 180 cars there. Rosie's would have to get permission from the Business bldg to the west but that hasn't been a problem in the past.

Tom said about Finishline that he didn't care for the club being associated with a bar.

Dan talked about Arapahoe Park (44th and Indiana , Golden Co)

NOTE: RMNC had a car show there in

1998. We can get 200 Cars on grass. There is a brick restroom bldg. We feel that we could get by with two portal potties at \$100 ea. This includes the potties plus pickup and delivery. The charge for the park is \$250. This pays for trash pickup, cleaning up the brick restroom bldg, electricity we use and any lawn sprinkler damage. The park has a playground, covered shelters with picnic facilities. There is a paved parking lot where we can set up vendors if we choose too, and the DJ for music because of the electrical hookup.

After discussing what we thought other shows charge vendors we agreed upon a \$35 vendor fee. Depending on the number of vendors we get, we might be able to balance out the charges against the vendor fees.

Dan has given the date of the Car Show to the Lady that rents the park and she said that we would have first choice and would let us know if somebody else wanted the date. Arapahoe park has commercial & residential area around the park, so as long as we don't start the music till 9am, there should be no problem with noise affecting homeowners.

Some shows that have been there in the past : Sons of Italy, Red Lions before they moved to their new location, Denver Roadsters, FOMOCO Club.

If we are to grow the show, we need a place to keep coming back to !

After discussion we took a vote: Heritage Square- 0 / Rosie's - 0 / Arapahoe Park - Unanimous

#2 Direct Impressions Artwork. Tom Koehler talked to Direct Impressions and they will change the artwork, no charge.

We have a short time people, we need Sponsors, Sponsors for Plaques, and Door Prizes.

Dan will lock in the date May 3rd, and will try to get a rain date (extreme weather), the show is rain or shine.

Bob Baron will contact Tracey at the Scoop and try to get the site changed in the next Scoop (April Issue)

Stuck will get with Midwest Autobody in Longmont and get them to change the listing in the 2009 Rod Run Schedule.

Dan will work on Changing the flyers to reflect the change and have some for the FEB 25th meeting.

Jan Ellinger will get with the Insurance Co. about the new location change.
