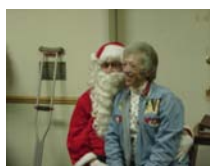

ELECTIONS

Elected Officers. The elected officers of this club shall be;

President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer.

No member may hold more than one elected office at a time. A majority of votes cast shall elect a member to office. No more than one officer per family.

Nominations. One meeting prior to the annual meeting, nominations for the required office shall be taken from the floor. **Nominations will be at the Jan. meeting.**

1. If only one candidate is nominated for an office, a voice vote may be taken for that office immediately. The name of the elected member shall be published in the next newsletter.
2. An absent member may not be nominated for an office, unless consent is given to the president prior to nominations.

Elections: When more than one candidate is nominated for an office, elections shall be by ballot vote at the annual meeting.

1. The ballot shall be printed in the newsletter for the members to mail or bring to the annual meeting.
2. The number of votes cast and the number cast for each candidate shall be entered into the meeting minutes.

Term of Office: Officers shall serve **for two years**. March 1 through February 28/29th, or until their successors are elected. (Voted on and Revised 1/12/2008).

Vacancies: A vacancy in elected office shall be filled as follows:

1. The office of President shall be filled by the Vice President.
2. The office of Vice President shall be filled by special Election at the next meeting after the vacancy is announced.
3. The office of Secretary and/or Treasurer shall be filled by Presidential appointment, subject to ratification at the next club meeting. A majority vote shall provide ratification.

Appointed Officers: The appointed officer of this club shall be:

A **Newsletter Editor, Car Show Chairperson, Sunshine person** and **Club Historian**. - (Voted on and Revised 1/12/08).

MEMBERS AND DUES

Members - - - Classes of Membership:

1. Member-- One who pays dues annually and is eligible to vote at club meetings
2. Family - A spouse and dependant child (children) of a member shall be included in the membership of the club. The spouse shall be eligible to vote.
3. Honorary - A membership may be granted, to a person who by majority vote of the membership, be exempt from paying dues. Shall not be eligible to vote or hold office.

Dues

Annual club dues shall be **\$ 24.00 per member, per year**. With payment of the dues the member shall receive the monthly newsletter, a copy of the by-laws, and a club roster.

1. Dues of new members shall be paid at time of application, as prorated to January at \$ 2.00 per month
2. Dues of members shall be paid every January after initial application. Any member who does not **pay dues by January 31**, will automatically forfeit their membership.
3. Dues paid to the club are non-refundable.
