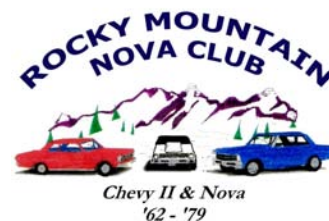
be some changes just because different people do things different ways, but it will stay the same for the most part.
