ACTICLE VII. OFFICERS

- Section A. Elected officers. The elected officers of this club shall be: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer. No member may hold more than one elected office at a time. a majority of votes cast shall elect a member to office.
- Section B. Nominations. One meeting prior to the annual meeting nominations for the required office shall be taken from the floor.
1. If only one candidate is nominated for an office, a voice vote may be taken for that office immediately. The name of the elected member shall be published in the next newsletter.
 2. An absent member may not be nominated for an office unless consent is given to the president prior to nomination.
- Section C. Elections. When more than one candidate is nominated For an office, elections shall be by ballot vote at the annual Meeting.
1. The ballot shall be printed in the newsletter for the Members to mail or bring to the annual meeting.
 2. The number of votes cast and the number cast for each Candidate shall be entered in the minutes.
- Section D. Term of Office. Officers shall serve for one year, March 1 through February 28/29th, or until their successors are elected. (voted on and revised 1/92).

The Term of office has been changed to two years.
